This is second petition filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.112 dated 23.07.2014, registered under Sections 406, 420, 498-A and 120-B IPC at Police Station Women Patiala, District Patiala.

I have heard the counsel at great length.

It needs to be said in the beginning that the petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail. Anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner on 27.01.2015. The zimni orders show that the petitioner failed to furnish the surety bonds before the trial Court. Only personal bonds were furnished. The case was adjourned a number of times only for the purpose. Thereafter, applications for personal exemptions were filed. The trial Court exempted their appearance on 28.09.2015. The trial Court dismissed the application filed thereafter and issued non-bailable warrants. The witnesses were discharged. The case was adjourned to 09.10.2015, 30.10.2015, 21.11.2015 and then to 10.12.2015 and thereafter proceedings

under Section 82 Cr.P.C. were initiated. The petitioner was ultimately declared proclaimed person and proceedings under Section 299 Cr.P.C. were initiated.

No case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed. The petitioner would surrender before the trial Court on 28.03.2016.
