This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.124 dated 15.05.2016 registered under Sections 307/186/353 /332/342/506/435/511/148/149 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that invocation of Section 307 IPC is highly debatable because no weapon has been used

and the petitioners have been in custody since 16.05.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar has accepted the fact that no weapon was used but states that even without weapon an intention to kill can be there.

Without commenting on the merits or arguments of both counsel and keeping in view the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
