The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 75 dated 17.09.2014 registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar City under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

The complainant is present in the Court today. A draft of Rs. 1 lac has been handed over to her.

Report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per the report parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the complainant has pointed out that Rs. 10,000/- was to be paid to the complainant as directed by this Court vide order dated 20.11.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that they shall pay the amount in other proceedings.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is **allowed** and interim order dated 20.08.2015 is hereby made absolute subject

to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
