JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 177, dated 22.10.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the India Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rajound, District Kaithal.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he has refused to pay back a sum of Rs. 2.5 lacs to the complainant, who stood as a guarantee for purchase of buffaloes by the petitioner-accused. This fact has come in the enquiry proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2015 and further contends that the petitioner is willing to pay back the remaining amount.

Learned State Counsel by referring the order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal, states that previously a compromise was effected between the parties, which was backed out by the petitioner while also threatening the complainant to implicate him in a case of attempt of rape or under the SC/ST Act.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
