Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.29 dated 18.03.2016, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 354, 452, 506 and 34 IPC.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from investigation officer, has informed that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 31.08.2016 and at this stage, his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.08.2016, passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim

anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute. The

petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
