The petitioner was found in possession of 115 grams of
intoxicant powder, which on analysis was found to contain
alprazolam.

Taking into consideration the marginally higher quantity
of the contraband, recovered from the petitioner, than the

commercial quantity and the petitioner being not involved in any other case, he can be granted the concession of bail, adopting the reformatory approach.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. In case the petitioner is found to be indulging in similar activities, this order will automatically cease to exist and the petitioner will be liable to be arrested again.
