Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No. 81 dated 28.03.2016, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 363/366-A IPC and (Section 376 IPC added lateron).

After going through the contents of the petition, it seems that it is a case of run away marriage where the daughter of the complainant had solemnized marriage with the petitioner and had further sought protection from the Sessions Court on 14.03.2016 (P-2) wherein the prosecutrix stated that she intends to go with her husband.

Keeping in view the fact that it is a case of run away marriage and the prosecutrix wants to go with the petitioner, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
