Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.152 dated 11.07.2016, registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab, the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated August 22, 2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that earlier the FIR lodged by the father of the complainant was investigated and found to be false. Be that as it may, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar fairly states that the petitioner has joined the investigation. In my opinion, only the amount of ₹2,40,000/- in cash allegedly paid by the complainant to the petitioner for getting the same returned by way of pension @ ₹5,000/- per month, is an act in which the complainant should

thank himself.

In that view of the matter, order dated August 22, 2016 made by this Court granted interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
