The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.64, dated 29.5.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34, 326(added later-on) of the IPC, at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the injured has since long been discharged and the petitioners have now been in custody since 5.6.2016.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder

Singh, does not deny the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM, Amritsar.

Petition stands disposed of.
