By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.93, dated 13.05.2016, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

It is contended that the petitioner was arrested on 13.05.2016 for possessing 13 unlabeled injections and 13 unlabeled bottles. The chemical report has still not been received.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the prayer of bail and states that the recovery was effected from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He informs that the FSL

report is still awaited.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In view of the above and keeping in view the law laid down by a Division Bench of this Court in *Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi Vs. State of Punjab, 2014(3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 953*, the Court feels that ends of justice would be met if the petitioner is allowed interim bail, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction CJM/Illaqa Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

However, if the chemical report is found to be positive, the same shall be intimated/forwarded to the petitioner who shall surrender before the competent Court within a week thereafter.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
