The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.69 dated 3.6.2014 under section 22 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Mehta, District Amritsar City.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 200 grams of intoxicant powder.

Report of the Chemical Examiner having been received, the recovery was found to be containing the salt of Dipenoxylate Hydrochloride. The same would be construed as commercial in quantity.

Faced with such a situation, counsel submits that he would not be pressing the instant petition.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
