The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.69, dated 11.6.2016, registered under Sections 324, 326, 34 & 326
(added later-on) of the IPC, at Police Station Dhariwal, District
Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the present

petitioners were empty handed and have not caused any injury.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, has accepted this factual assertion. Counsel for the complainant, however, points out that the petitioners were all part of a group.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners were empty handed, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to them. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
