The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.19, dated 28.4.2016, registered under Sections 353, 186, 323, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, states that the matter has been settled but asserts that at the time when the incident happened, the victim was on official duty.

Be that as it may, at this state this Court is concerned only

with the issue of grant of anticipatory bail and is not giving any opinion on the merits of case. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 29.09.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
