Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49 dated 31.07.2016, registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa, under Section(s) 306, 34 IPC.

On 22.08.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 05.10.2016.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioners they shall be released on interim bail by the investigating officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, it is clarified that the petitioners shall be present before the investigating officer as and when their presence is required.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector

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Gurnaib Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for any investigation.

The allegations are that the deceased had developed intimacy with the daughter of petitioner No.1 Hem Singh and the petitioners were trying to stop the relationship and were threatening him.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 22.08.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
