The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.37, dated 9.5.2016, registered under Sections 308, 336, 341, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 12.5.2016 and the victim has since been discharged from hospital.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Deep Singh, has accepted this factual assertion but has argued that this is a case of serious offence where head injury was given by the petitioner.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
