No one has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 4 despite service.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 15.7.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mansa in Criminal Complaint No. 224 dated 16.11.2007.

Perusal of order dated 15.7.2015 reveals that after framing of the charge, an application for examining the witnesses as per the list moved by legal representatives of the deceased complainant Taranjit Kaur has been dismissed. It has been observed that a similar application was moved at pre charge evidence.

The complainant seeking to lead evidence by producing on record

copy of the FIR and compromise dated 15.5.2011 to show that the alleged dowry articles were in the possession of the respondents and they have admitted this fact and agreed to return the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.7.2015 (Annexure P-1) is set aside and the present petition is allowed. An opportunity is granted to the petitioner to move an application for leading evidence in the criminal complaint.
