JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Rajwant Kaur-petitioner seeking direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to inquire into and investigate and to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 and 5 while acting on the representations made by her.

2. Pursuance to the notice of motion issued by this Court vide order dated August 20, 2015, a detailed inquiry was got conducted by deputing Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Gurdaspur as is evident from an affidavit of Kulwant Singh Sidhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent,

Central Jail, Gurdaspur and he found the allegations to be unsubstantiated vide his report (Annexure R-1/T). Another inquiry was conducted by AIG Crime (Commission) BOI, Punjab, Chandigarh and he also concurred with the conclusion arrived at by the Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Gurdaspur.

3. In view of the reports submitted by the aforesaid officers, no further action is required to be taken in the matter. Rather, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to her under law.
