The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 249 dated 17.7.2016 registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur under Sections 363, 366-A IPC.

Petitioner is in custody since 20.7.2016. Challan has not been presented yet. The girl went missing on 15.7.2016. She was recovered five days later. She had refused to get her medical done. In her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she has supported the petitioner. She is stated to be over 16½ years old. The trial will take time

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing local surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty

Magistrate with the condition that the petitioner would not tamper with the evidence.
