Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 01.03.2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib

The allegation against the petitioner is that she along with her non-applicant/co-accused Jagtar Singh @ Tari is involved in a scam of preparing counterfeit currency notes.

There is a recovery of Rs.46,000/- counterfeit currency notes from the possession of petitioner/accused-Parwati Devi @ Parvati whereas Rs.51,000/- counterfeit currency notes from her non-applicant/co-accused Jagtar Singh @ Tari.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and she is in custody since 01.03.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Dharam Singh, submits that the case is at the initial stage of recording of prosecution evidence.

Keeping in view the active role of the petitioner/accused, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
