ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 56 dated 16.04.2015, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 363, 366-A read with Section 120-B IPC and Section 17 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned counsel urges that the trial against the co-accused had ended in acquittal and the prosecutrix did not stand by her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel urges that girl was minor and she had made a statement against the petitioner and her medical was done and spermatozoa was found and the petitioner is a proclaimed offender.

Perusal of order dated, Annexure P-2 shows that the sister of the petitioner had been allowed regular bail since there was a compromise.

The petitioner is a proclaimed offender and is not entitled to anticipatory

bail. The petition is dismissed.
