The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 145 dated 12.4.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B IPC at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as no incriminating evidence or documents were found against him. He is not named in the FIR and arrested only on the statement of main accused Neeraj @ Sunil. The petitioner is behind the bars since 27.4.2016 and his co-accused have already been released on bail by the Court vide order dated 24.6.2016.

Learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the bail application and states that the petitioner has got opened the account in the name of other person impersonating himself as that other person on the basis of forged documents and he has taken active part in the embezzlement.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the case file.

The challan has been presented in the Court and the trial is going on. The petitioner is in custody only since 27.4.2016. Keeping in view the gravity of offence, this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
