INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.57 dated 21.05.2016, registered at Police Station Machhiwara, District Khanna, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that the present FIR has been registered on the basis of statement of Harjit Kaur. It is alleged in the FIR that on 17.05.2016, commission agent, Mukhtiar Singh (present petitioner) and non-applicant Gurmeet Singh forcibly cultivated the land of complainant and took possession of the same. They even made an attempt to take possession of half of complainant's house. It is also

alleged in the FIR that it was revealed that the commission agent had purchased the land from her husband-Gurdip Singh, but no sale deed qua the same was shown. However, the complainant party had not received any sale consideration.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
