This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.149 dated 11.05.2015 registered under Sections 302/201/148/149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind.

On 21.09.2016 the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 12.05.2015.

Learned State counsel submits that it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and prays for an adjournment to place on record the affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Jind to the effect that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence within three months from today subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Adjourned to 06.10.2016.”

Today the affidavit of Shashank Anand, IPS Superintendent of Police, Jind on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record, as per which the prosecution undertakes to conclude its entire evidence on or before 20.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed. In view of this undertaking it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its evidence in the manner indicated above, the Court shall release the petitioner on bail on 20.12.2016 to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
