JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Balbir Singh in Complaint Case No.28 dated 27.08.2012 under Sections 420, 506 of Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of SDJM, Ajnala, wherein he has been summoned to face trial.

There are allegations of receipt of money by the petitioner for sending the son of the complainant abroad.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to face the trial.

Learned Counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed

the grant of bail.

In view of the nature of the proceedings and the fact that the petitioner is willing to face trial, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of petitioner submitting himself before the trial Court within 10 days from today, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
