INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.27 dated 29.02.2016, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, Kapurthala, under Section 379 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

As per the allegation in the FIR, electric wires have been stolen from the fields of Balkar Singh. It is also alleged in the FIR that the complainant also came to know that theft of electric wires have been committed from other villages also by some unknown persons. The present petitioner has been nominated in this case.

In the present case, recovery is still to be effected, therefore,

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custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

Keeping in view the allegations made in the FIR and in view of the facts that recovery is yet to be effected and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
