The petitioners were granted concession of bail by this Court. A petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for directing the Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala to release the petitioners from custody as release orders have already been issued by the trial Court.

On making queries from counsel for the petitioner, it transpires that the release warrants have been returned with the remarks that in the custody warrants, available with the jail authorities, offence under Sections 302, 201, 363, 366-A, 376, 34, 120-B IPC have been mentioned but in the release warrant offences under Sections 363, 366-A and 34 IPC are not mentioned.

This petition is disposed of with a clarification that the petitioners have been granted the concession of bail in FIR No. 223 dated 30.08.2015 under Sections 302, 201, 363, 366-A, 376, 34, 120-B IPC which are mentioned in the custody warrants but on account of all the said Sections, having not been mentioned in the heading of the title before this Court, Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 34 IPC appear to have not

been incorporated in the release warrants.

On the oral request of the petitioner, it is ordered that the order passed by this Court on 09.08.2016, will be deemed to have been passed under Sections 302, 201, 363, 366-A, 376, 34, 120-B IPC. Petitioners may be released, as per the release warrants issued pursuant to the orders passed by this Court.
