KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 16 dated 10.04.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed and affidavit dated 04.08.2015 and 05.08.2015 (*Annexure P-2 and P-3*) respectively.

Report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the all the complainants and accused have been recorded. Both the parties have entered into a compromise. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

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Since, the parties have amicably settled their financial dispute, therefore, FIR No. 16 dated 10.04.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

In view of the above, the present petition stands allowed.
