Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.81, dated 01.07.2016, for offence punishable under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amristar.

This Court, vide order dated 22.08.2016, has granted interim bail to the petitioners, however, subject to their joining investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order dated 22.08.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Major Singh, also submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 22.08.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
