This is a petition for the grant of regular bail to the present petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 54 dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 3498-A, 304-B, 201, 120-B and Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his parents killed his wife Pooja(daughter of the complainant) by giving her some intoxicant and cremated her forcibly.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that out of 10 prosecution witnesses, examination-in-chief of only 3 witnesses has been recorded.

Keeping in view the above circumstances, there is no ground to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Petition is dismissed.
