The petitioner is alleged to have entered the house of Bijender with country made pistol for committing robbery.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of bail.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and gone through the facts and circumstances of the case. In the present case, Bijender and his wife, the material witnesses, are yet to be examined. The petition is dismissed, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court for grant of bail after examination of the said witness. It is made clear that if for any reason the complainant fails to put in appearance and delay the proceedings, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again before recording the statement of the complainant and other material witnesses.
