INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.66 dated 20.05.2016, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that 6 strips of Carisoma, each containing 10 tablets, 8 strips of Alto, each containing 10 tablets and 3 vials of Avil 10 ml. were recovered from the present petitioner.

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Learned State counsel has not contested the fact that the aforesaid recovery falls in non-commercial quantity.

The petitioner has been in custody since 20.05.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
