The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 20.12.2015 on the allegation that he was found carrying 700 tablets of MICROLIT containing total 52.2 grams of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed under the law. Petitioner in said circumstances, can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not indulge in a similar activity, of which he is accused of, in the present case, during the entire period of trial and will not in any manner induce or threaten the witnesses.
