This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.76 dated 29.05.2016 registered under Sections 363/366/34 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the allegations the sister of the complainant was enticed away by the son of the petitioner and another friend of his. Both the boys are missing as well as the girl. The father of the other boy was also arrested and was granted regular bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner has been in custody since 31.07.2016 and as per him has nothing to do with the disappearance of the sister of the complainant since she is a major and seems to have run away with the son of the petitioner.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted the above mentioned facts.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
