This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.112, dated 15.07.2015 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from the merits the petitioner is suffering from the last stage of cancer.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that the medical certificate placed on record is quite old.

In my opinion it would be in the interest of justice if the petitioner appear before the trial Court on 13.09.2016 and shows latest medical record and in case it is found that the petitioner is suffering from the terminal diagnosis of cancer she will be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.

The petition is allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
