Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that the matter is still under investigation. Allegations are serious in nature. Money on the pretext of providing loans to such girl students who enrolled for a tailoring course by a society, namely, Bright Future Skilled Work Welfare Society under the hold and control of the present petitioner has been raised. The total money collected is alleged to be Rs.70 lacs approximately. The complainants/victims are stated to be 176 in all.

This Court is not inclined to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner under such circumstances.

The present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of regular bail is as such dismissed at this stage.
