This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for providing the security to the petitioners and for not harassing the petitioners on any false criminal complaint if lodged by any of private respondents or relatives of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Surender Kumar, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State, whereas, Mr. Neeraj Januha, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned counsel for the respondents, during the course of the day.

On request of learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 who are parents of the petitioners intend to talk with their daughter, namely, Seeta and for that purpose they were allowed to talk with petitioner No.1 and after having a talk, subsequent thereto, respondents

No.4 as well as respondent No.5, who were present in the Court room left the Court before second hearing.

Accordingly, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated August 19, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
