JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought directions to the police authority to get the investigation to logical end with regard to FIR No. 101, dated 30.07.2014, Police Station Nangal Roopnagar.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Madan Lal, Police Station Nangal Roopnagar has submitted that after investigation of the matter, untraced report was presented by the police in the Court of Id. Jurisdictional Magistrate in respect of FIR, in question, but that report has not been accepted by SDJM, Sri Anandpur Sahib and a direction has already been issued for proper investigation.

3. Since, a necessary direction has already been given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar for further investigation of the matter, the

instant petition has rendered infructuous and it stands disposed of accordingly.

4. However, it is directed that investigation be conducted by Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
