This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect/safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the matter was reported by way of representation (Annexure P-6) to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, but till date no action has been taken.
