This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.76 dated 20.12.2013 registered under Sections 302/201/120-B IPC at Police Station Bhadaur District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.12.2013.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar states that only two witnesses remain and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire

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evidence on or before 27.10.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
