By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners have sought quashing of FIR No. 61, dated 31.03.2011, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Samrala, District Khanna and all other subsequent proceedings based thereupon.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel, on instructions, from HC Gurmit Singh, Police Station Samrala that after the completion of prosecution evidence and the recording of statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C., the trial is at its penultimate, which is now listed for 05.09.2016 for final hearing.

3. In view of the completion of evidence and that the trial is at its penultimate, the instant petition has rendered infructuous. As such, the same is dismissed.

4. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies or to take all the pleas taken in this petition before the trial court at the appropriate stage.
