This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.34 dated 18.02.2016 registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala under Section 379 IPC.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners would not press this petition and

would surrender before the trial Court but a direction should be issued to the trial Court to decide the application for regular bail, to be moved by the petitioners, expeditiously.

Learned Additional Advocate General states that she would have no objection if this course of action is followed.

In the circumstances, it is directed that in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court on or before 06.09.2016 and move an application for regular bail the same be decided by the trial Court expeditiously but in any case on or before 09.09.2016.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
