The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in cross version case/GD No.26, dated 30.4.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 120-B, 326 (added lateron) of the IPC in FIR No.25, dated 30.4.2016, registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that this is a case of

version and cross version where differences are between the sister and

brother and the injury which is described as grievous is on the left forearm of the injured.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from SI Satnam Singh, has accepted that this is a case of version and cross version but states that in the version put-forward by the petitioner, the injury attributed to the accused therein is under Sections 323/324 of the IPC.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
