The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.308 dated 05.08.2014, under Sections 15/25/29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner would vehemently contend that the alleged recovery is not from the conscious possession of the petitioner and the petitioner as such has been falsely implicated. It is further contended that the petitioner was arrested three months after the alleged recovery and he has been in custody since 02.11.2014.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court

is not inclined to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

The alleged recovery in the present case is of 250 Kgs of poppy husk. Such recovery is stated to have been made from the house of the petitioner. Recovery of contraband is commercial in nature.

Petition is dismissed.
