This petition has been filed under Section 407 Cr.P.C. for transfer of criminal complaint bearing No.1594 dated 02.05.2016 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments (Annexure P-3) from the District Court of Patiala to the District Court of Ludhiana on the ground that two other complaints filed by the respondent against the petitioners are pending at the District Court, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that in view of the amendment in Section 142-A of the Negotiable Instruments Act all

subsequent petitions between the same parties would have to be filed at Ludhiana only.

Learned counsel for the respondent has fairly accepted this contention.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The said complaint is directed to be transferred to the District Court at Ludhiana.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
