INDERJIT SINGH, J.

This order shall dispose of CRM-M-29204-2016, filed by petitioner-Dinesh and CRM-M-29783-2016, filed by petitioner-Ram Kishan, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 08.06.2016, registered at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506 and 34 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in both these cases. Learned State

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counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 23.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-29204-2016 and dated 27.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-29783-2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are now not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from the present petitioners.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody, I find merit in both these petitions and the same are allowed. The orders dated 23.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-29204-2016 and dated 27.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-29783-2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
