This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 173 dated 22.11.2014 under Sections 498-A, 494, 406, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at P.S. City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Keeping in view the challan has been presented on 25.11.2016, counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to take all the pleas before the trial Court. He also prays for exemption for personal appearance of the petitioner. The petition is disposed of keeping in view the allegations made on petitioner which is general in nature.

Meanwhile, personal appearance of petitioner before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) petitioner shall be represented through counsel;
- (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- (iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused:

- (iv) shall have no objection if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence, but in the presence of their counsel;
- (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and
- (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
