Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in FIR No.0128 dated 1.6.2016 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, though the name of the petitioners do not find mentioned, but still, they are being called by the police and are made to sit at the police station for long time. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 10.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) to respondent no.3 in this regard and petitioners would be satisfied at

this stage, if a direction is issued to respondent no.3 to look into the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2).

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to look into the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) and act in accordance with law.
