The petitioner is alleged to be a part of scam of leakage of question papers of various posts in PUNSUP prior to the date of the examination. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he had allegedly worked as conduit for Sham Lal Gupta, M.C. Malout and had enticed one candidate, Rajesh Rajpal by introducing him to co-accused Sukhpreet Singh and Amandeep Singh who had taken the candidate to Lucknow for showing the paper to him.

The petitioner was involved in two other cases of similar nature in which he has been released on bail under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. In the present case, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 01.07.2016.

Co-accused of the petitioner, similarly circumstanced, have been granted the concession of bail by this Court.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate subject to the

condition that he will not leave India without the permission of the Court and deposit his passport with the investigating agency before his release within a period of seven days. In case, he does not possess any passport, he would be required to furnish an affidavit to that extent before the investigating agency.
