Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 22.05.2015 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 05.04.2016. Challan has been presented on 27.06.2016 and the trial will take long time. He states that the petitioner had earlier filed a petition which was dismissed as withdrawn on 08.07.2016.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact, however, states that the petitioner was instrumental in getting money, collected from innocent complainant for which he has given receipt to the complainant.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody since 05.04.2016 and the offence as referred in the FIR is triable by Magistrate. The trial in the case will take long time and, therefore, the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that the trial Court shall admit the petitioner on bail subject to his furnishing adequate personal surety and the local surety or any other condition as it may deem fit.
