This petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against the respondents No.4 to 8 and investigate the complaint dated 02.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) which was sent to the respondent No.3 and further reminder dated 13.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) which was sent to the respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.3 violated Section 166-A IPC by not entertaining the complaint of the petitioner.

Hence without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the matter and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) and reminder (Annexure P-2) expeditiously in accordance with law.
